

## SIP Source Address Filter Setup Guide

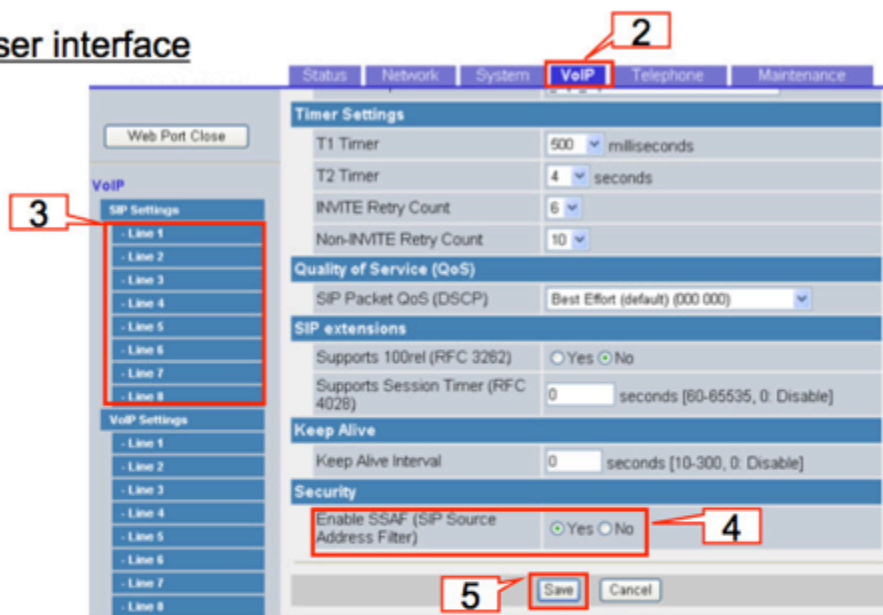
Phantom Calls are SIP Invites coming from an unexpected place or coming from an incorrect route. This behavior is marked by:

- Ringing, and when answered only dead air is heard
- Sometimes anonymous Caller ID
- Sometimes Request URI address is invalid
- Caller ID can look like an extension that does not exist on the system

Panasonic 5xx series phones have SIP Source Address Filter which can be used to block these Phantom Calls from occurring.

### Turn ON SSAF (SIP Source Address Filter)

#### Via Web user interface



1. Enter the IP Address into a PC's web browser
2. Login as "Administrator"
3. Move to the VoIP - Line 1 screen
4. Select "Yes" at "Enable SSAF (SIP Source Address Filter)"
5. Click Save
6. Repeat steps for Line 2 - Line 8
