

Voicemail Text Notifications Guide


The VirtualPBX system can send emails to notify you of an incoming voice or fax message. You can leverage this with cell phone providers email to text feature to get text messages alerting you of incoming voice or fax messages.

Go to the **Message Handling** tab per extension



Checkmark the box for Voice notification and/or Fax notification as desired.

After email delivery, place a copy of voice and fax messages in: Inbox Saved Deleted
